NOTICE OF RACE

Saturday, 18 Sep 2010

- 1. RULES:** Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009-2012 as modified by the 2010 TSR Sailing Instructions.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:** Open to all monohull keelboats LOA 20' or greater, belonging to members of Langley Yacht Club (LYC), Norfolk Naval Sailing Association (NNSA), or Old Point Comfort Yacht Club (OPCYC). Entry fee: **\$25**. Race entries due by skipper's meeting, 17 Sep 2010; RC *may* reject late entries. Send entries to: **John Ritter, 107 Ivy Arch, Yorktown VA 23693** (Cell: 757-329-6992), checks payable to Langley Yacht Club. For PHRF N, include a copy of the valid PHRF rating. Boats must comply with PHRF of the Chesapeake Category 4 Safety Requirements and Special Regulations.
- 3. CLASSES:** PHRF N (2HS) and a single HS, non-spinnaker Cruising Class for boats without a valid PHRF Rating (LYC will assign Cruising boats courtesy handicaps, which may not be appealed). RC may combine or split classes as required based on the number of entries.
- 4. COURSES:** Government fixed mark course; Start will be near Mark Y (Day Beacon R2, off Buckroe Beach).
- 5. SCHEDULE OF RACES:** First warning at 1000L, RC ship's time; a rolling start based on splits announced at the skipper's meeting is intended.
- 6. SKIPPER'S MEETING:** 7:00 PM, Friday, 17 Sep at Water's Edge Grill (Salt Ponds Marina, Buckroe Beach Rd). All pertinent documentation will be posted to the LYC website by 9:00 PM.
- 7. AWARDS:** 1st, 2nd, 3rd per announced split in each Class. Overall: TSR Cup to the club with the greatest club score.
- 8. SOCIAL:** Water's Edge Grill, Salt Ponds Marina, 18 Sep 7:00 PM-???
